

# Identifying Leg Bands and Recording Sightings

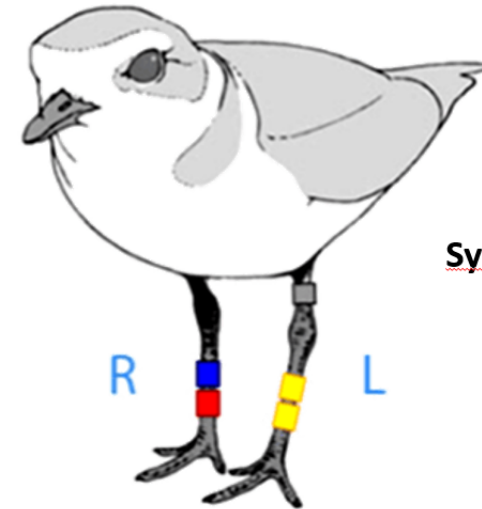
## Band Colors

(underlined, **bold-faced** letter is code for color)

 <u>a</u> qua	 <u>r</u> ed
 <b>b</b> lue	 <u>v</u> iolet
 <u>g</u> reen	 <u>w</u> hite
 <u>l</u> ime	 <u>y</u> ellow
 <u>o</u> range	 <b>black</b>
 <u>p</u> ink	 <u>t</u> an

S or X=Silver or Metal Bands, U=unbanded on one leg.

## How to Read Bands



- Bands are read Left to Right, Top to Bottom
- Most WSP have 2 bands on each leg
- Some are located above the leg joint (these are CAPITALIZED)
- Some WSP will have bi-colored or striped bands.  
\*Use a / symbol to report these, for example:  
Pw:ob/w
